

Statement of Nature's Classroom Institute Security Policy

Nature's Classroom Institute of Wisconsin, Inc. (NCI) is aware of the need for the highest level of security for its participating students and teachers. To ensure the security of our facility and visitors, we have the following security and risk management protocols in place:

- All teaching staff at NCI and all service staff (who are the employees of B'nai B'rith Beber Camp) have undergone security background checks through National Background Investigations, Inc.
- The staff of NCI performs an emergency drill with every group that participates in our program within an hour of their arrival. A surprise drill follows this emergency procedure within twenty-four hours. These drills include information on fire, tornado, and electrical emergencies. Our fire drill procedure and alarm systems are evaluated twice yearly by the East Troy fire department.
- Every NCI staff member is required to carry high-powered two-way radios while out in the field. Our administrative staff and/or medical personnel are required to monitor the two-way radios during all program times.
- No visitor, prior to checking in at the main NCI office, is permitted contact with the students.
- No parent, guardian, relative or friend is permitted to visit with any child unless written school permission is given prior to the arrival of the parent, guardian, relative or friend. Telephone consents from either the principal of the school or the permission given by the on-site school representative (lead teacher) may substitute in cases of emergency.
- All medical procedures must be coordinated through our medical staff. No student may participate in the NCI program unless they have submitted the following forms:
 - Emergency Medical Authorization, Waiver, and Release of Liability
 - Medication Permission and Administration Form
 - Student Home and Health Information
